DAILY ITINERARY

Day 1: Sunday, October 09, 2011

Overnight Flight Depart Canada for our flight to Tel Aviv (In flight meals) Today we embark on our Journey to the Holy Land. Prepare yourself for a life-changing experience. Get some rest on the flight... tomorrow you will be walking where Jesus walked!

Day 2: Monday, October 10, 2011

Arrive Tel Aviv, Israel – Jerusalem Arrive in Tel Aviv and transfer to one of the Holiest cities in the world, Jerusalem. Tonight, join your fellow travelers for a Welcome dinner. Today dinner will be included.

Day 3: Tuesday, October 11, 2011

Jerusalem – Your day begins with a visit to the Mount of Olives. Afterwards, visit the Church of All Nations built over the rock on which Our Lord prayed the night before he was crucified. Then, spend devotional time at the Garden Tomb, the possible site of the garden of Joseph of Arimathea and site of the resurrection of Jesus. Lunch on your own. Enjoy an afternoon of leisure to explore the city at your own pace. Tonight, walk through Jaffa gate to the Old City, (UNESCO) which combines the beauty of what is old with an allure that is timeless and visit the Citadel (also known as the Tower of David). The walls of the Citadel serve as a stage for a “Night Spectacular”* show which is a celebration of sight and sound. Amidst the archaeological remains in the Citadel’s courtyard and to the sound of original music, the story of Jerusalem unfolds through giant breathtaking, virtual reality images. Today breakfast and lunch will be included.

Day 4: Wednesday, October 12, 2011

Jerusalem – Masada – Dead Sea – Jerusalem Enjoy a full day excursion to some of the most historic regions in Israel. First, take a ten minute cable car ride to the top of Masada, where a small group of Jewish zealots stood up the attack of the Roman legion and emerged victorious even in defeat. In 2001, Masada was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Tour the remnants of the palace fortress, complete with Roman style bathhouses built by King Herod, as well as storehouses, ritual baths and synagogues built by the Jews. Stand on the summit plateau for

stunning views of the Dead Sea and the surrounding Judean Desert. Experience an oasis in the desert at the Kibbutz Ein Gedi Country Hotel. Enjoy lunch at the Botanical Garden Restaurant then come and float on the salty waters of the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth. Return to Jerusalem tonight for free evening of relaxing or check out a schedule of suggested evening events. Today breakfast and Dinner will be included.

Day 5: Thursday, October 13, 2011

Jerusalem – Bethlehem – Jerusalem Travel to Bethlehem, the birthplace of Jesus (Luke 2), enter the Church of the Nativity, the oldest continuously functioning church in the world. View the cave where Jesus was born. Stop at Shepherds’ Field where the angels appeared on that first Christmas night, spreading good tidings of great joy for all the people. Later, visit Yad Vashem Holocaust Memorial, established in 1953, as the world centre for documentation, research, education and commemoration of the Holocaust. “And to them will I give in my house and within my walls a memorial and a name (a “yad vashem”)... that shall not be cut off.” (Isaiah, chapter 56, verse 5). Evening at leisure to explore Jerusalem. Today breakfast and dinner will be included.

Day 6: Friday, October 14, 2011

Jerusalem – Tel Aviv – Jerusalem Travel to Tel Aviv for a tour of Jaffa. Here you will have the opportunity to stroll through this ancient port, visit the markets and shops. Tel Aviv is a UNESCO World Heritage Site as the Bauhaus Architectural Capital of the World. This afternoon, visit the Latrun Tank museum and learn about some of the historical and political challenges of the nation. Enjoy an evening at leisure. Today breakfast and Dinner will be included.

Day 7: Saturday, October 15, 2011

Jerusalem – Sea of Galilee – Tiberias This morning, pack your suitcase as you travel north for an overnight adventure to Galilee. Cross the waters of the Sea of Galilee aboard a replica of the type of boat in which Jesus would have sailed. Travel to the Mount of Beatitudes where Jesus preached the “Sermon on the Mount” (Matthew 5-7). In

Capernaum, Jesus performed many miracles and it was the centre of Jesus' ministry in Galilee. Visit the synagogue that stands on the site where Jesus taught and reflect on his teaching and preaching of the gospel of the kingdom (Matthew 4:13, 23). Get a taste of the local flavour when you enjoy lunch at a communal settlement, known as a Kibbutz, in the Golan Heights. (lunch on your own). Your day ends at the River Jordan. Today breakfast, and dinner will be included.

Day 8: Sunday, October 16, 2011

Tiberias – Nazareth – Haifa – Caesarea – Jerusalem

Travel to Nazareth, Jesus' boyhood home (Matthew 2:23), and visit the place where Joseph's home and workshop were as well as the site of the fresh water spring used by the Holy Family. Visit to Mt. Carmel where Elijah battled the priests of Baal. Next, enjoy a panoramic view of Haifa and Gardens of Mount Carmel. Later visit the Roman Aqueduct and Theatrea Caesarea, a centre of the early Christians where Cornelius became the first Gentile convert to the new covenant (Acts 10) by St. Peter and Paul was imprisoned before taken to Rome for trial (Acts 23). The evening is yours to enjoy back in Jerusalem. Today breakfast and dinner will be included.

Day 9: Monday, October 17, 2011

Jerusalem Today you are free to explore the city on your own. Tonight, enjoy a very special farewell dinner (Surprise location) as you say farewell to this amazing city. Today breakfast and dinner will be included.

Day 10: Tuesday, October 18, 2011

Jerusalem - Tour Ends transfer to Tel Aviv (Ben Gurion airport) for our flight home Today breakfast will be included.

Please Note: Air rate and schedule are applicable for groups of 10 or more traveling on the same flights and dates. To complete your vacation, we include roundtrip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of purchasing these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times. Due to flight schedules, you may require a very early morning departure from the hotel on the last day (Day 10). Travel distance from Jerusalem to Tel Aviv's Ben Gurion airport is approximately 1 hour and 30 minutes (depending upon traffic conditions). Due to security checks, it is recommended that you arrive at Ben Gurion airport 3 hours prior to departure. Proper dress is required when visiting religious sites, sanctuaries, basilicas, etc. Canadian Christian Tours air passengers will depart from Tel Aviv airport and all transfers will depart from Jerusalem for the Tel Aviv airport.

*The light show at the Tower of David is dependant upon good weather conditions.

This tour requires average physical activity. You should be in good health, able to climb stairs and walk reasonable distances, possibly over uneven grounds and cobblestone streets.
